

# **IBBA - ERG Double Degree Programme**

## **Faculty Language Requirements**

- S7 entrants admitted into the double degree programme are required to fulfill the faculty language requirements of both the BA and Engineering faculties.
- S6 entrants admitted into the double degree programme are required to fulfill the S6 faculty language requirements of the first degree programme and the S7 faculty language requirements of the second degree programme.
- The Engineering Faculty language required course ELT1111 (3 units) and its associated units could be exempted if the students have successfully completed ELT1100 (3 units) or ELT2550 (3 units) in their first degree in BA.

## **Course and Unit Exemptions**

The following course and unit exemptions will apply to students registered for the IBBA+ERG double degree programme:

- (1) Students successfully completing DSE2010 Statistical Analysis for Business Decision I (3 units) in their first degree will be exempted from taking and the units of SEG2430 Applied Probability and Statistics (3 units) in their second degree in Engineering.
- (2) Students successfully completing DSE2050 Information Systems and E-Commerce (4 units) in their first degree will be exempted from taking and the units of SEG3490 Information Systems Management (3 units) in their second degree in Engineering.

## **Major/Faculty Requirement for S6 Entrants**

Apart from fulfilling the Major/Faculty requirement for S6 entrants of their first degree in BA, all BA students of S6 entrants in the IBBA-ERG double degree option are also required to complete 9 units of courses from the following list to fulfil the Major/Faculty requirement for S6 entrants of the Faculty of Engineering:

- (i) ERG1010 Engineering Electronics
- (ii) MAT1110 University Mathematics for Engineering
- (iii) PHY1001 General Physics I
- (iv) 3 units of any Engineering Faculty course(s) subject to the approval of the Major Department/academic advisor
