"Dos" in the Interview

To help you prepare for your interview, the following "Dos" are summarized from our students' past experiences for your attention:

1. Well prepared for the interview
 - Study the information of your target university(ies), and the city(ies) /country(ies) it/they locate(s) from the World Wide Web or the resources in OAL.
 - Have clear objective of exchange, i.e. Why you want to go on exchange? What do you want to learn/achieve through the overseas exchange?
2. Show your confidence, positive and outgoing personality in the interview.
3. Answer questions or present your views with detailed explanations. Don't just answer "Yes" / "No" or in short sentences.
4. Take initiative to ask questions in the end of interview.

Hope this can give you some insights to prepare for your interview.
